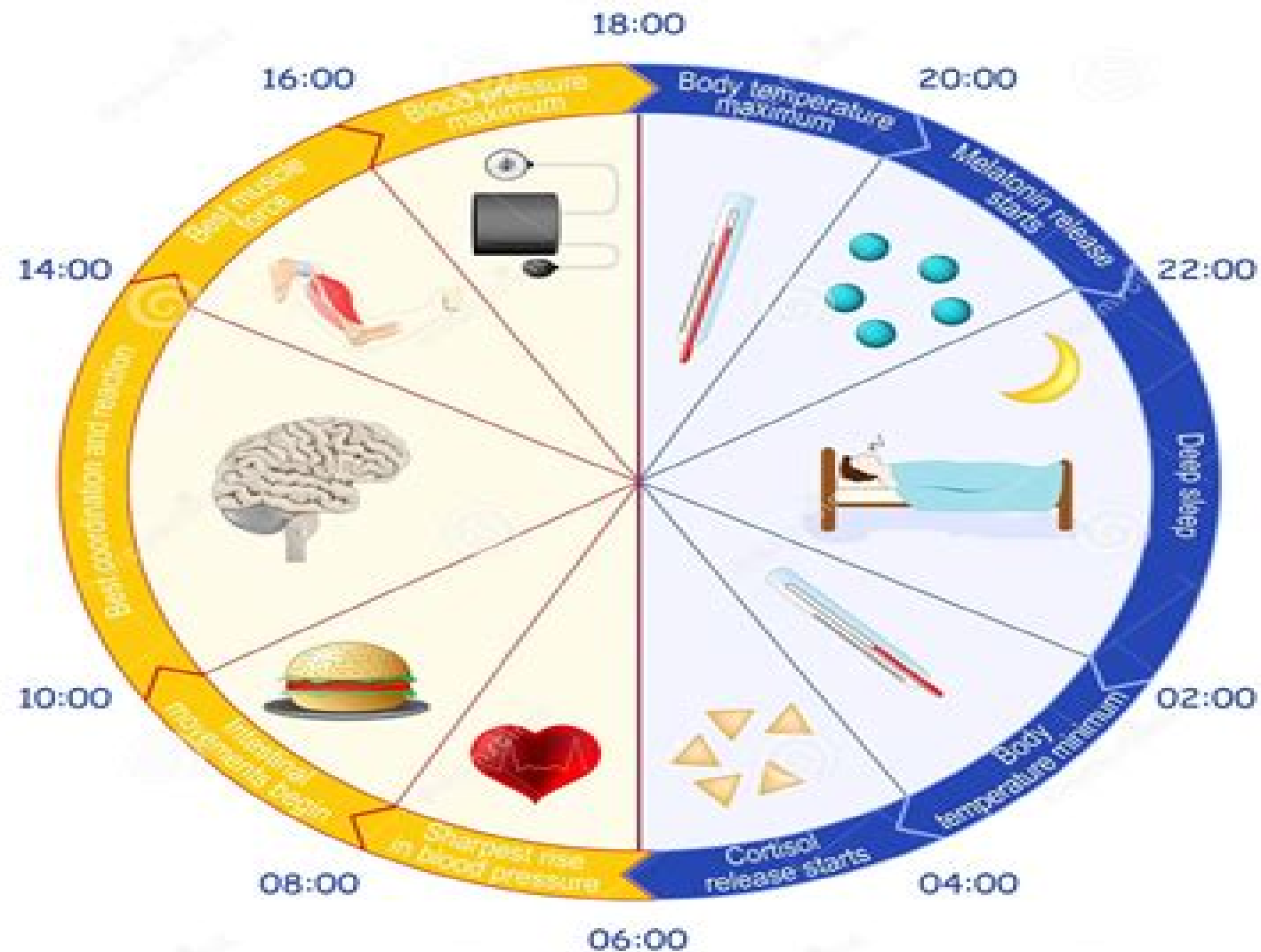

The time of day you take medication can affect how well it works. And Palmer shows that when our clocks are thrown off, kilter trouble follows, especially for rotating shift workers, the Bhopal spill, the Chernobyl reactor explosion, and the Three Mile Island accident, all happened when new crews began early hour shifts. No one has discovered exactly how our internal clocks work, Palmer says, a Nobel Prize awaits that lucky scientist, but they are no less fascinating for their inexplicable nature.
