Analogy-making as Perception Melanie Mitchell, 1993 The psychologist William James observed that a native talent for perceiving analogies is the leading fact in genius of every order The centrality and the ubiquity of analogy in creative thought have been noted again and again by scientists artists and writers and understanding and modeling analogical thought have emerged as two of the most important challenges for cognitive science Analogy Making as Perception is based on the premise that analogy making is fundamentally a high level perceptual process in which the interaction of perception and concepts gives rise to conceptual slippages which allow analogies to be made It describes Copycat a computer model of analogymaking developed by the author with Douglas Hofstadter that models the complex subconscious interaction between perception and concepts that underlies the creation of analogies In Copycat both concepts and high level perception are emergent phenomena arising from large numbers of low level parallel non deterministic activities In the spectrum of cognitive modeling approaches Copycat occupies a unique intermediate position between symbolic systems and connectionist systems a position that is at present the most useful one for understanding the fluidity of concepts and high level perception On one level the work described here is about analogy making but on another level it is about cognition in general It explores such issues as the nature of concepts and perception and the emergence of highly flexible concepts from a lower level subcognitive substrate Melanie Mitchell Assistant Professor in the Department of Electrical Engineering and Computer Science at the University of Michigan is a Fellow of the Michigan Society of Fellows She is also Director of the Adaptive Computation Program at the Santa Fe Institute

Subsymbolic Natural Language Processing Risto Miikkulainen, 1993 Risto Miikkulainen draws on recent connectionist work in language comprehension to create a model that can understand natural language Using the DISCERN system as an example he describes a general approach to building high level cognitive models from distributed neural networks and shows how the special properties of such networks are useful in modeling human performance In this approach connectionist networks are not only plausible models of isolated cognitive phenomena but also sufficient constituents for complete artificial intelligence systems Distributed neural networks have been very successful in modeling isolated cognitive phenomena but complex high level behavior has been tractable only with symbolic artificial intelligence techniques Aiming to bridge this gap Miikkulainen describes DISCERN a complete natural language processing system implemented entirely at the subsymbolic level In DISCERN distributed neural network models of parsing generating reasoning lexical processing and episodic memory are integrated into a single system that learns to read paraphrase and answer questions about stereotypical narratives

Miikkulainen's work which includes a comprehensive survey of the connectionist literature related to natural language processing will prove especially valuable to researchers interested in practical techniques for high level representation, inferencing, memory modeling and modular connectionist architectures. Computational Approaches to Analogical Reasoning: Current Trends Henri Prade, Gilles Richard, 2014-03-22 Analogical reasoning is known as a powerful mode for drawing plausible conclusions and solving problems. It has been the topic of a huge number of works by philosophers, anthropologists, linguists, psychologists and computer scientists. As such it has been early studied in artificial intelligence with a particular renewal of interest in the last decade. The present volume provides a structured view of current research trends on computational approaches to analogical reasoning. It starts with an overview of the field with an extensive bibliography. The 14 collected contributions cover a large scope of issues. First the use of analogical proportions and analogies is explained and discussed in various natural language processing problems as well as in automated deduction. Then different formal frameworks for handling analogies are presented dealing with case based reasoning, heuristic driven theory projection, commonsense reasoning about incomplete rule bases, logical proportions induced by similarity and dissimilarity indicators and analogical proportions in lattice structures. Creating Scientific Concepts Nancy J Nersessian, 2010-08-13

An account that analyzes the dynamic reasoning processes implicated in a fundamental problem of creativity in science how does genuine novelty emerge from existing representations How do novel scientific concepts arise In Creating Scientific Concepts Nancy Nersessian seeks to answer this central but virtually unasked question in the problem of conceptual change She argues that the popular image of novel concepts and profound insight bursting forth in a blinding flash of inspiration is mistaken Instead novel concepts are shown to arise out of the interplay of three factors an attempt to solve specific problems the use of conceptual analytical and material resources provided by the cognitive social cultural context of the problem and dynamic processes of reasoning that extend ordinary cognition Focusing on the third factor Nersessian draws on cognitive science research and historical accounts of scientific practices to show how scientific and ordinary cognition lie on a continuum and how problem solving practices in one illuminate practices in the other Her investigations of scientific practices show conceptual change as deriving from the use of analogies imagistic representations and thought experiments integrated with experimental investigations and mathematical analyses She presents a view of constructed models as hybrid objects serving as intermediaries between targets and analogical sources in bootstrapping processes Extending these results she argues that these complex cognitive operations and structures are not mere aids to discovery but that together they constitute a powerful form of reasoning model based reasoning that generates novelty This new approach to mental modeling and analogy together with Nersessian s cognitive historical approach make Creating Scientific Concepts equally valuable to
