encompassed education and pedagogy philosophical questions church and Quaker history as well as the political issues of the day Jones dealt with such issues as justice democracy and child rearing His ideas are still alive today and still arouse controversy He was particularly anxious to avoid the cultivation of an elite pleading instead for individual growth and personality development Over the course of his life he was awarded twelve academic titles taught at numerous universities delivered countless lectures and was one of the first theologians to recognise the significance of radio and to make full use of it To this day Rufus Jones is still honored as a seer Protestant mystic and even as a Master Quaker and Quaker Giant It is time also to take a critical look at these honors The Morality of Self-Defense and Military Action David B.
