



(NY22)NEW YORK, July 13--COLLAPSES IN COURT--Alice Crimmins lies on the floor of a New York City courtroom, Monday, after collapsing there while surrendering to face first-degree murder and first-degree manslaughter charges in the deaths of her two children in 1965. Mrs. Crimmins was convicted in 1968 of murdering her daughter, Alice Marie, and was sentenced to five to 29 years in jail.
