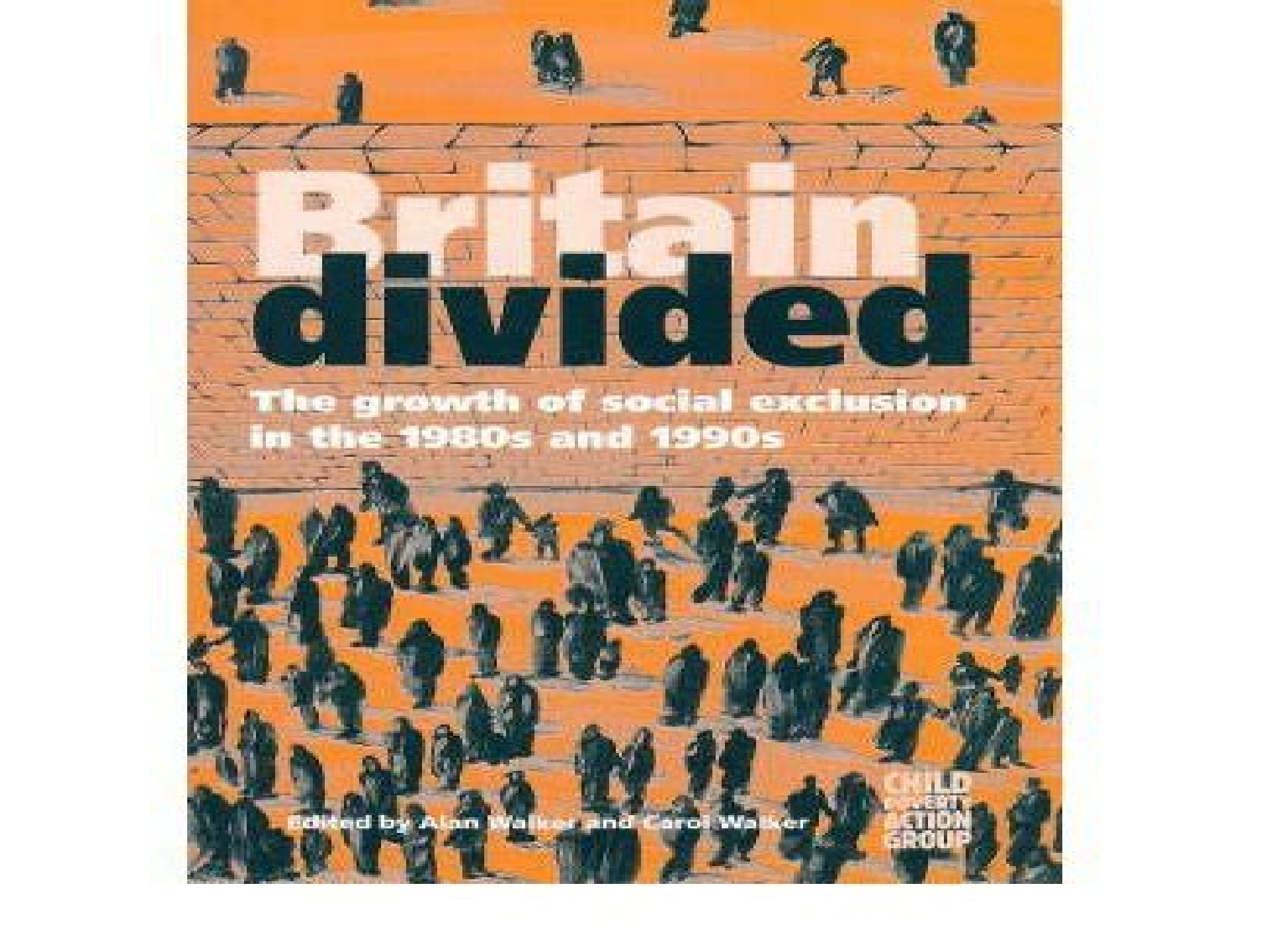

Homelessness Amanda Grenier, 2022-01-15 Around the world and across a range of contexts homelessness among older people is on the rise In spite of growing media attention and new academic research on the issue older people often remain unrecognized as a subpopulation in public policy programs and homeless strategies As such they occupy a paradoxical position of being hypervisible while remaining overlooked Late Life Homelessness is the first Canadian book to address this often neglected issue Basing her analysis on a four year ethnographic study of late life homelessness in Montreal Canada Amanda Grenier uses a critical gerontological perspective to explore life at the intersection of aging and homelessness She draws attention to disadvantage over time and how the condition of being unhoused disrupts a person's ability to age in place resulting in experiences of unequal aging Weaving together findings from policy documents stakeholder insights and observations and interviews with older people this book demonstrates how structures organizational practices and relationships related to homelessness and aging come to shape late life Situated in the context of an aging population rising inequality and declining social commitments Late Life Homelessness stresses the moral imperative of responding justly to the needs of older people as a means of mitigating the unequal aging of unhoused elders **Unequal Security** Peter

Starke, Laust Lund Elbek, Georg Wenzelburger, 2024-09-30 We live in an age of insecurity The Global Financial Crisis the Covid 19 pandemic the wars in Ukraine and Gaza and the climate crisis are just the most evident examples of shocks that have increased the level of insecurity among elites and citizens in recent years And yet there is ample evidence that insecurity is not equally distributed across populations Bringing together disciplines such as political science criminology sociology and anthropology and combining quantitative and qualitative studies from a wide range of rich and middle income countries this collection presents a new framework for exploring the two key social challenges of our times insecurity and inequality together The volume analyses the nature causes and distribution of subjective insecurities and how various actors use or respond to unequal security The essays cover a host of themes including the unequal spatial distribution of insecurity unequal access to security provision in relation to crime and welfare the impact of insecurity on political attitudes as well as policy responses and the political exploitation of insecurity An important contribution to debates across several social scientific disciplines as well as current public debate on insecurity and politics the volume will be of great interest to scholars and researchers of criminology social policy peace and conflict studies politics and international relations sociology development studies and economics It will also be of interest to policymakers and government think tanks

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
