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Restoration and Revolution in Britain Gary S. Beier,2016-02-05 Authorities ranging from philosophers to politicians nowadays question the existence of concepts of society whether in the present or the past This book argues that social concepts most definitely existed in late medieval and early modern England laying the foundations for modern models of society The book analyzes social paradigms and how they changed in the period A pervasive medieval model was the body social which imagined a society of three estates the clergy the nobility and the commonalty conjoined by interdependent functions arranged in static hierarchies based upon birth and rejecting wealth and championing poverty Another model the book describes as social humanist that fundamentally questioned the body social advancing merit over birth mobility over stasis and wealth over poverty The theory of the body social was vigorously articulated between the 1480s and the 1550s Parts of the old metaphor actually survived beyond 1550 but alternative models of social humanist thought challenged the body concept in the period advancing a novel paradigm of merit mobility and wealth The book s methodology focuses on the intellectual context of a variety of contemporary texts

Thomas Fuller W. B. Patterson,2018-02-09 Long considered a highly distinctive English writer Thomas Fuller 1608 1661 has not been treated as the significant historian he was Fuller s The Church History of Britain 1655 was the first comprehensive history of Christianity from antiquity to the upheavals of the Protestant and Catholic Reformations and the tumultuous events of the English civil wars His numerous publications outside the genre of history sermons meditations pamphlets on current thought and events reflected and helped to shape public opinion during the revolutionary era in which he lived Thomas Fuller Discovering England s Religious Past highlights the fact that Fuller was a major contributor to the flowering of historical writing in early modern England W B Patterson provides both a biography of Thomas Fuller s life and career in the midst of the most wrenching changes his country had ever experienced and a critical account of the origins growth and achievements of a new kind of history in England a process to which he made a significant and original contribution The volume begins with a substantial introduction dealing with memory uses of the past and the new history of England in the late sixteenth and early seventeenth centuries Fuller was moved by the changes in Church and state that

came during the civil wars that led to the trial and execution of King Charles I and to the Interregnum that followed. He sought to revive the memory of the English past recalling the successes and failures of both distant and recent events. The book illuminates Fuller's focus on history as a means of understanding the present as well as the past and on religion and its important place in English culture and society.

The Revolution in Freedoms of Press and Speech Wendell Bird, Wendell R. Bird, 2020. This book discusses the revolutionary broadening of concepts of freedom of press and freedom of speech in Great Britain and in America in the late eighteenth century in the period that produced state declarations of rights and then the First Amendment and Fox's Libel Act. The conventional view of the history of freedoms of press and speech is that the common law since antiquity defined those freedoms narrowly and that Sir William Blackstone in 1769 and Lord Chief Justice Mansfield in 1770 faithfully summarized the common law in giving a very narrow definition of those freedoms as mere liberty from prior restraint and not liberty from punishment after something was printed or spoken. This book proposes to the contrary that Blackstone carefully selected the narrowest definition that had been suggested in popular essays in the prior seventy years in order to oppose the growing claims for much broader protections of press and speech. Blackstone misdescribed his summary as an accepted common law definition which in fact did not exist. A year later Mansfield inserted a similar definition into the common law for the first time also misdescribing it as a long accepted definition and soon misdescribed the unique rules for prosecuting sedition as having an equally ancient pedigree. Blackstone and Mansfield were not declaring the law as it had long been but were leading a counter revolution about the breadth of freedoms of press and speech and cloaking it as a summary of a narrow common law doctrine that in fact was nonexistent. That conflict of revolutionary view and counter revolutionary view continues today. For over a century a neo Blackstonian view has been dominant or at least very influential among historians. Contrary to those narrow claims this book concludes that the broad understanding of freedoms of press and speech was the dominant context of the First Amendment and of Fox's Libel Act and that it enjoyed greater historical support.
