In addition, 'Be Ready for Reading' provides a variety of mathematical activities including colour, number and shape recognition.

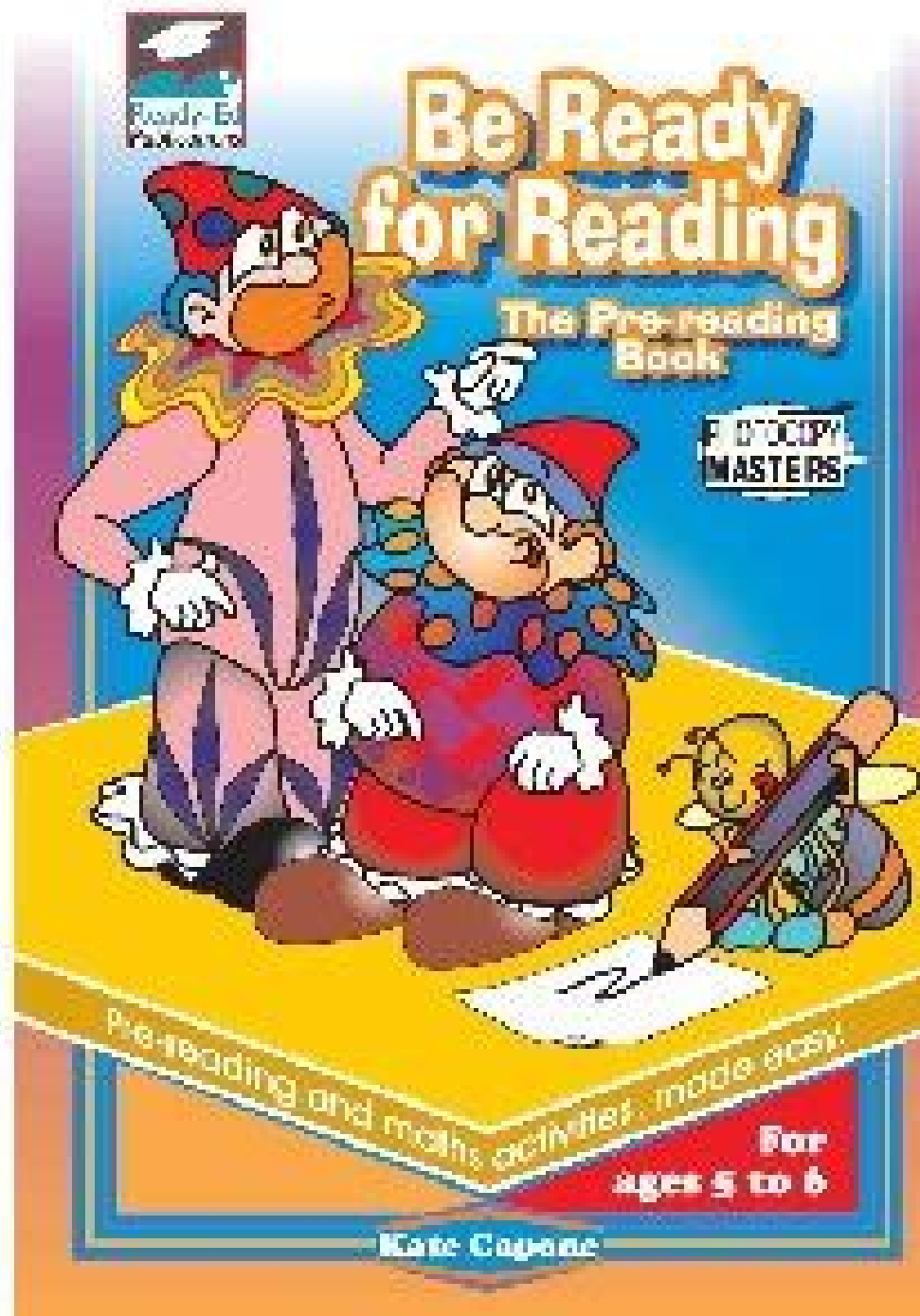
