The Internationalisation of the 'Native Labour' Question in Portuguese Late Colonialism, 1945-1962 José Pedro Monteiro, 2022-11-22 This volume addresses the ways the native labour question in the Portuguese late colonial empire in Africa became a recurrent topic of international and transnational debate and regulation after the Second World War As other European colonial empires were tentatively transforming their labour and social policies in the aftermath of the war the Portuguese Empire in Africa resisted significant changes in this domain preserving a strict dual labour regime As a result a growing number of individuals networks and institutions abroad engaged with labour and social realities in Portuguese African colonies giving origin to a series of instances of denunciation of labour related abuses Portuguese authorities responded to these initiatives by selectively engaging with international norms languages and mechanisms However as global decolonisation gained momentum international and transnational events and processes would significantly constrain Portuguese imperial and colonial decision making procedures with the aim of retaining the empire Therefore the native labour question became in its own right a crucial political and diplomatic element of the broader struggles over the meaning of Portuguese imperial legitimacy As this volume argues these historical processes are critical to properly understanding the history of Portuguese late colonialism and its protracted trajectory of decolonisation

Football and Colonialism Nuno Domingos, 2017-07-25 In articles for the newspaper O Brado Africano in the mid 1950s poet and journalist Jos Craveirinha described the ways in which the Mozambican football players in the suburbs of Lourenço Marques now Maputo adapted the European sport to their own expressive ends Through gesture footwork and patois they used what Craveirinha termed malice or cunning to negotiate their places in the colonial state These manifestations demand a vast study Craveirinha wrote which would lead to a greater knowledge of the black man of his problems of his clashes with European civilization in short to a thorough treatise of useful and instructive ethnography In Football and Colonialism Nuno Domingos accomplishes that study Ambitious and meticulously researched the work draws upon an array of primary sources including newspapers national archives poetry and songs and interviews with former footballers Domingos shows how local performances and popular culture practices became sites of an embodied history of Mozambique The work will break new ground for scholars of African history and politics urban studies popular culture and gendered forms of domination and resistance

Diamonds in the Rough Todd Cleveland, 2015-07-15 Diamonds in the Rough explores the lives of African laborers on Angola's diamond mines from the commencement of operations in 1917 to the colony's independence from Portugal in 1975 The mines were owned

and operated by the Diamond Company of Angola or Diamang which enjoyed exclusive mining and labor concessions granted by the colonial government Through these monopolies the company became the most profitable enterprise in Portugal's African empire After a tumultuous initial period the company's mines and mining encampments experienced a remarkable degree of stability in striking contrast to the labor unrest and ethnic conflicts that flared in other regions Even during the Angolan war for independence 1961-75 Diamang's zone of influence remained comparatively untroubled Todd Cleveland explains that this unparalleled level of quietude was a product of three factors African workers' high levels of social and occupational commitment or professionalism the extreme isolation of the mining installations and efforts by Diamang to attract and retain scarce laborers through a calculated paternalism The company's offer of decent accommodations and recreational activities as well as the presence of women and children induced reciprocal behavior on the part of the miners a professionalism that pervaded both the social and the workplace environments This disparity between the harshness of the colonial labor regime elsewhere and the relatively agreeable conditions and attendant professionalism of employees at Diamang opens up new ways of thinking about how Africans in colonial contexts engaged with forced labor mining capital and ultimately each other
