**Marine Macroecology** Jon D. Witman, Kaustuv Roy, 2009-10-15 Pioneered in the late 1980s the concept of macroecology a framework for studying ecological communities with a focus on patterns and processes revolutionized the field Although this approach has been applied mainly to terrestrial ecosystems there is increasing interest in quantifying macroecological patterns in the sea and understanding the processes that generate them Taking stock of the current work in the field and advocating a research agenda for the decades ahead Marine Macroecology draws together insights and approaches from a diverse group of scientists to show how marine ecology can benefit from the adoption of macroecological approaches Divided into three parts Marine Macroecology first provides an overview of marine diversity patterns and offers case studies of specific habitats and taxonomic groups In the second part contributors focus on process based explanations for marine ecological patterns The third part presents new approaches to understanding processes driving the macroecological patterns in the sea Uniting unique insights from different perspectives with the common goal of identifying and understanding large scale biodiversity patterns Marine Macroecology will inspire the next wave of marine ecologists to approach their research from a macroecological perspective

**Deep Cut** Christine Keiner, 2020-12-15 This book is openly available in digital formats thanks to a generous grant from the Andrew W Mellon Foundation The Atlantic Pacific Central American sea level canal is generally regarded as a spectacular failure However Deep Cut examines the canal in an alternative context as an anticipated infrastructure project that captured attention from the nineteenth through the late twentieth centuries Its advocates included naturalist Alexander von Humboldt physicist Edward Teller and U S presidents John F Kennedy Lyndon Johnson and Jimmy Carter The waterway did not come to fruition but as a proposal it served important political and scientific purposes during different eras especially the years spanning the Cold War and the environmental decade of the 1970s Historian Christine Keiner shows how the evolving plans for the sea level ship canal performed distinct kinds of work for diverse historical actors in light of shifting scientific environmental and diplomatic values Dismissing it as a failed scheme prevents us from considering the political cultural and epistemological processes that went into constructing the seaway as an innovative diplomatic solution to rising U S Panama tensions an exciting research opportunity for evolutionary biologists a superior hydrocarbon highway for the oil industry or a serious ecological threat to marine biodiversity Invoking past dreams and nightmares of peaceful nuclear explosives invasive sea snakes and the 1970s energy crisis Deep Cut uses the Central American seaway proposal to examine the changing roles of environmental diplomacy and state sponsored environmental impact assessment More broadly Keiner amplifies an emerging

conversation around the environmental scientific and political histories and legacies of unrealized megaprojects **Atlantic Shorelines** Mark D. Schmieder, 2013-03-09 Rocas Alijos lies 180 nautical miles west of Baja California It comprises several exposed rocks that surmount a large oceanic volcano rising from the ocean floor well off the continental shelf It is located at the transition zone between two major biologic provinces at a latitude where the Pacific Current turns westward to form the north Pacific trans oceanic current In spite of its obvious importance for biogeographical studies the remoteness of Rocas Alijos and its small size thwarted any major scientific work until very recently and the topography biota and oceanographic conditions of the site remained largely unknown During 1990 and again in 1993 Cordell Expeditions a nonprofit research organization based in Walnut Creek California undertook expeditions to describe the site A scientific team of 30 was onsite 31 October 7 November 1990 and a scientific team of 12 was onsite 10 15 February 1993 Since most of the Rocas Alijos site is subtidal much of the

examination and specimen collection was done by scuba although several remote sampling techniques were also used The exposed rocks were sampled by climbers and megafauna were observed from shipboard

**Animal Migration, Orientation and Navigation** Gauthreaux, 2012-12-02 Animal Migration Orientation and Navigation presents the various aspects of animal migration including the evolution of migration climatic and meteorological influences and bioenergetics This book discusses the physiological control sensory systems orientation and navigation and biological clocks and phenology aspects of animal migration Organized into five chapters this book begins with an overview of the migration strategies of animals in the context of a space continuum This text then explains the influence of short and long term climatic cycles on the spectrum of migratory patterns in nature Other chapters consider the energetic requirements of different migration strategies and the energy stores of the migrants This book discusses as well the physiological basis of animal migration with emphasis on endocrinal findings on the timing and energetic aspects of different migration strategies The final chapter deals with the mechanisms used in direction finding by migrating animals This book is a valuable resource for biologists and ecologists

Bioorganic Marine Chemistry , 2013-03-08 Burgeoning research into marine natural products during the past two decades has in no small measure been due to an heightened and world wide interest in the ocean to the development of new sophisticated computer driven instrumentation and to major advances in separation science Organic chemists have been fully aware that processes in living systems occur in an aqueous medium Nevertheless the chemists who have specialized in the study of small molecules have found it expedient to use organic rather than aqueous solvents for the isolation and manipulation of secondary metabolites The emergence of new chromatographic techniques the promise of rewarding results not to mention the relevance of polar molecules to life itself have contributed to a new awareness of the importance of organic chemistry in an aqueous medium The first chapter in Volume 2 of Bioorganic Marine Chemistry reflects the growing interest and concern with water soluble compounds Quinn who pioneered the separation of such molecules has contributed a review which closely links techniques with results and is based on practical experience The second chapter by Stonik and Elyakov examines the vast chemical literature of the phylum Echinodermata over one fourth of it in difficultly accessible Russian language publications The Soviet authors evaluate the data for their suitability as chemotaxonomic markers
