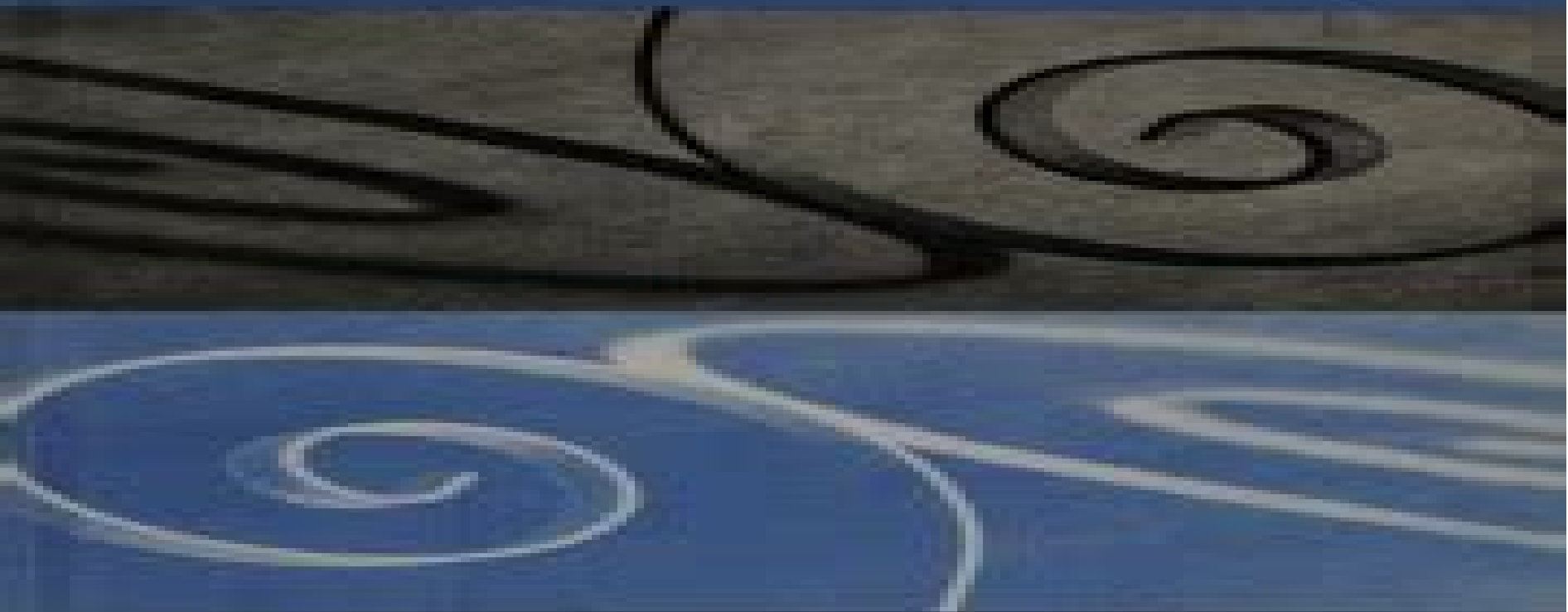


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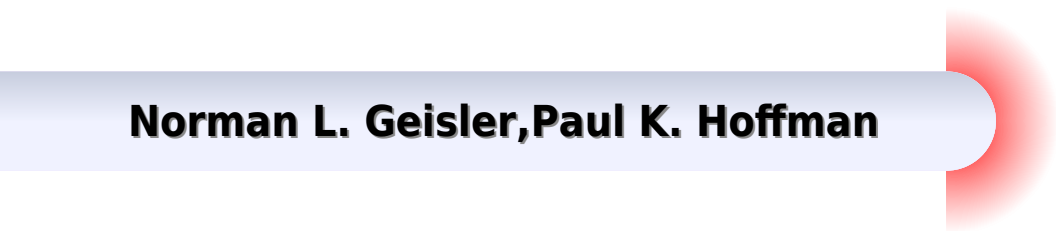

Persons, Moral Worth, and Embryos Stephen Napier, 2011-06-21 Bioethicists have achieved consensus on two ideas pertaining to beginning of life issues 1 persons are those beings capable of higher order cognition or self consciousness and 2 it is impermissible to kill only persons As a consequence a consensus is reached regarding the permissibility of both destroying human embryos for research purposes and abortion The present collection aims to interact critically with this consensus Authors address various aspects of this orthodoxy Issues discussed include theories of personhood and in particular the role of thought experiments used in support of such theories the notion of an intrinsic potential and the moral relevance of having one new formulations of the virtue argument against abortion rights

Palpant, 2013 Human Dignity in Bioethics brings together a collection of essays that rigorously examine the concept of human dignity from its metaphysical foundations to its polemical deployment in bioethical controversies The volume falls into three parts beginning with meta level perspectives and moving to concrete applications Part 1 analyzes human dignity through a worldview lens exploring the source and meaning of human dignity from naturalist postmodernist Protestant and Catholic vantages respectively letting each side explain and defend its own conception Part 2 moves from metaphysical moorings to key areas of macro level influence international politics American law and biological science These chapters examine the legitimacy of the concept of dignity in documents by international political bodies the role of dignity in American jurisprudence and the implications and challenges for dignity posed by Darwinism Part 3 shifts from macro level topics to concrete applications by examining the rhetoric of human dignity in specific controversies embryonic stem cell research abortion human animal chimeras euthanasia and palliative care psychotropic drugs and assisted reproductive technologies Each chapter analyzes the rhetorical use of human dignity by opposing camps assessing the utility of the concept and whether a different concept or approach can be a more productive means of framing or guiding the debate

Virtues in Action M. Austin, 2013-10-10 In recent decades many philosophers have considered the strengths and weaknesses of a virtue centered approach to moral theory Much less attention has been given to how such an approach bears on issues in applied ethics The essays in this volume apply a virtue centered perspective to a variety of contemporary moral issues and in so doing offer a fresh and illuminating perspective Some of the essays focus on a particular virtue and its application to one or more realms of applied ethics such as temperance and sex or humility and environmental ethics Other chapters focus on an issue in applied ethics and bring several virtues into a discussion of that issue or realm of life such as sport education and business Finally several of the chapters engage relevant psychological research as well as current neuroscience which enhances the strength of the philosophical arguments

The Nature of Human Persons Jason T. Eberl, 2020-06-25 For a human being to exist does it require an immaterial mind a physical body a functioning brain a soul Is there a shared nature common to all human beings What essential qualities might define this nature These questions are among the most widely discussed topics in the history of philosophy and remain subjects of perennial interest and controversy The Nature of Human Persons offers a metaphysical investigation of the composition of the human essence Jason Eberl also considers the criterion of identity for a developing human being that is what is required for a human being to continue existing as a person despite undergoing physical and psychological changes

over time Eberl places Thomas Aquinas's account of human nature into direct comparison with several prominent contemporary theories substance dualism emergentism animalism constitutionalism four dimensionalism and embodied mind theory These theories inform conclusions regarding when human beings first come into existence at conception during gestation or after birth how we ought to define death for human beings and whether and if so how human beings may survive death Ultimately *The Nature of Human Persons* argues that the Thomistic account of human nature addresses the matters of human nature and survival more holistically than other theories and offers a cohesive portrait of one's continued existence from conception through life to death and beyond

Politics for Christians Francis J. Beckwith asks whether teaching ID in public schools would be constitutional in light of the Supreme Court's decision in *Edwards v Aguillard* At that time the Court ruled that teaching creationism violates the Establishment Clause of the First Amendment of the U.S. Constitution Beckwith examines the Intelligent Design theory and the *Edwards* case to find out whether teaching ID would suffer the same fate if brought before the court
