Adam's Dream James Land Jones, 1975 The Challenge of Keats , 2016-09-27 Two centuries after his birth in October 1795 John Keats occupies a secure place in the canon of great literature of the western world But for much of the nineteenth century and even during periods of the twentieth century his right to such a position was not so firmly established On the bicentenary of Keats s birth various Italian scholars along with specialists from English speaking countries decided to take advantage of the occasion not only to render homage to a poet whose greatness now seems unchallenged but also to accept his continuing challenge to his readers The contributors to this volume re examine some of the harshest criticisms of Keats from Byron onwards and some of the unconditional exaltations of the poet in order to discover possible sites between the two for new critical impulses and fertile re evaluations of his achievement Under five headings Romantic Truth Textual Readings History and Myth Keats and Other Poets and Painting and Music the essays in this book appraise the historical cultural contexts that nurtured Keats s creativity discuss the influences and interrelationships among Keats and other poets and consider Keats s artistry as revealed in the analyses of particular texts *John Keats and the Ideas of the Enlightenment* Porscha Fermanis, 2009-09-23 John Keats is generally considered to be the least intellectually sophisticated of all the major Romantic poets but he was a more serious thinker than either his contemporaries or later scholars have acknowledged This book provides a major reassessment of Keats s intellectual life by considering his engagement with a formidable body of eighteenth century thought from the work of Voltaire Robertson and Gibbon to Hutcheson Hume and Smith The book re examines some of Keats s most important poems including The Eve of St Agnes Hyperion Lamia and Ode to Psyche in the light of a range of Enlightenment ideas and contexts from literary history and cultural progress to anthropology political economy and moral philosophy By demonstrating that the language and ideas of the Enlightenment played a key role in establishing his poetic agenda Keats s poetry is shown to be less the expression of an intuitive young genius than the product of the cultural and intellectual contexts of his time **Keats and Negative Capability** Li Ou, 2011-10-27 Negative capability the term John Keats used only once in a letter to his brothers is a well known but surprisingly unexplored concept in literary criticism and aesthetics This book is the first book length study of this central concept in seventy years As well as clarifying the meaning of the term and giving an anatomy of its key components the book gives a full account of the history of this idea It traces the narrative of how the phrase first became known and gradually gained currency and explores its primary sources in earlier writers principally Shakespeare and William Hazlitt and its chief Modernist successors W B Yeats and T S Eliot Meanwhile the term is also applied to Keats s own poetry which manifests the evolution of the idea in Keats s poetic practice Many of the comparative readings of the relevant texts including King Lear illuminate the interconnections between these major writers The book is an original and significant piece of scholarship on this celebrated concept Keats, Hermeticism, and the Secret Societies Jennifer N. Wunder, 2016-04-22 Jennifer Wunder makes a strong case for the

importance of hermeticism and the secret societies to an understanding of John Keats's poetry and his speculations about religious and philosophical questions. Although secret societies exercised enormous cultural influence during the late eighteenth and early nineteenth centuries, they have received little attention from Romantic scholars. And yet information about the societies permeated all aspects of Romantic culture. Groups such as the Rosicrucians and the Freemasons fascinated the reading public and the market was flooded with articles, pamphlets, and books that discussed the societies's goals and hermetic philosophies, debated their influence, and drew on their mythologies for literary inspiration. Wunder recovers the common knowledge about the societies and offers readers a first look at the role they played in the writings of Romantic authors in general and Keats in particular. She argues that Keats was aware of the information available about the secret societies and employed hermetic terminology and imagery associated with these groups throughout his career. As she traces the influence of these secret societies on Keats's poetry and letters, she offers readers a new perspective not only on Keats's writings but also on scholarship treating his religious and philosophical beliefs. While scholars have tended either to consider Keats's aesthetic and religious speculations on their own terms or to adopt a more historical approach that rejects an emphasis on the spiritual for a materialist interpretation, Wunder offers us a middle way. Restoring Keats to a milieu characterized by simultaneously worldly and mythological propensities, she helps to explain if not fully reconcile the insights of both camps.

Their stylistic masks allowed them to maintain the subjectivity and authenticity associated with the lyrical genre while simultaneously attaining greater objectivity and conveying multiple perspectives.
