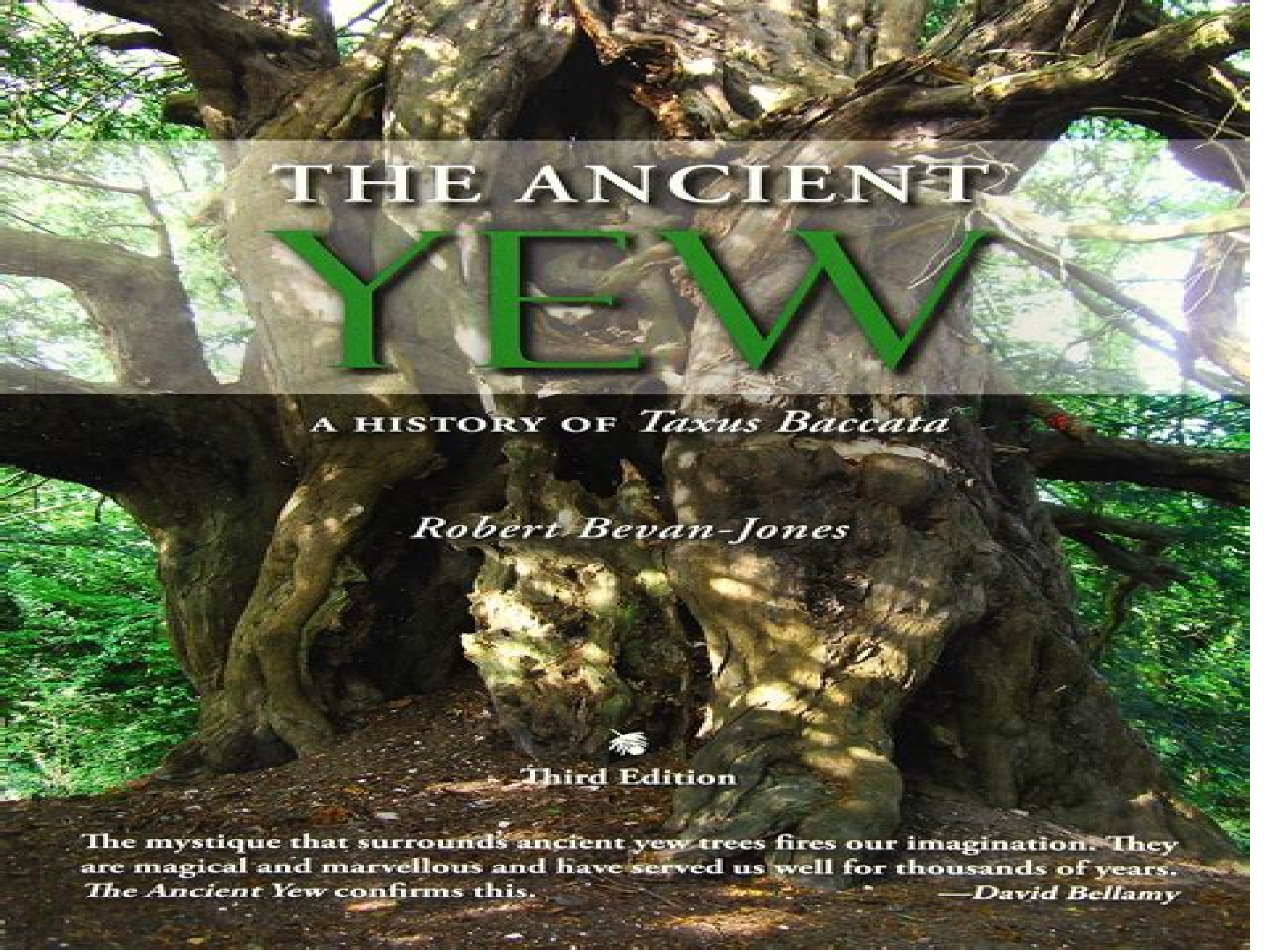

Yew Fred Hageneder, 2013-10-15 A comprehensive and richly illustrated history Yew will appeal to botanists and other readers interested in the history and symbolism of the natural world now in paperback The yew is the oldest and most common tree in the world but it is a plant of puzzling contradictions it is a conifer with juicy scarlet berries but no cones deer can feast on its poisonous foliage but it is lethal to farm animals and it thrives where other plants cannot because of its extraordinarily low rate of photosynthesis Exploring this paradoxical plant in Yew Fred Hageneder surveys its position in religious and cultural history its role in the creation of the British Empire and its place in modern medicine Hageneder explains the way the yew is able to renew itself from the inside by producing interior roots and how early humans fascinated with its regenerative powers began to associate the tree with concepts of life and death the afterlife and eternity As such it can be found at the sacred sites of Native Americans Buddhists and Shinto shrines in Japan and it has become a living symbol of the resurrection for the Christian faith He describes how churchyards saved many yews during the Middle Ages when the trees were used for the mass production of the longbow which laid the foundation for the British Empire Finally he discusses the latest scientific discoveries about the yew including its use in cancer treatments

The Lost Dark Age Kingdom of Rheged Ronan Toolis, Christopher Bowles, 2017-01-31 Trusty's Hill is an early medieval fort at Gatehouse of Fleet Dumfries and Galloway The hillfort comprises a fortified citadel defined by a vitrified rampart around its summit with a number of enclosures looping out along lower lying terraces and crags The approach to its summit is flanked on one side by a circular rock cut basin and on the other side by Pictish Symbols carved on to the face of a natural outcrop of bedrock This Pictish inscribed stone is unique in Dumfries and Galloway and southern Scotland and has long puzzled scholars as to why the symbols were carved so far from Pictland and even if they are genuine The Galloway Picts Project launched in 2012 aimed to recover evidence for the archaeological context of the inscribed stone but far from validating the existence of Picts in this southerly region of Scotland the archaeological context instead suggests that the carvings relate to a royal stronghold and place of inauguration for the local Britons of Galloway around AD 600 Examined in the context of contemporary sites across southern Scotland and northern England the archaeological evidence from Galloway suggests that this region may have been the heart of the lost Dark Age kingdom of Rheged a kingdom that was in the late sixth century pre eminent amongst the kingdoms of the north The new archaeological evidence from Trusty's Hill enhances our perception of power politics economy and culture at a time when the foundations for the kingdoms of Scotland England and Wales were being laid

Trees and Timber in the Anglo-Saxon World Michael D. J. Bintley, Michael G. Shapland, 2013-10-03 Trees were of fundamental importance in Anglo Saxon society Anglo Saxons dwelt in timber houses relied on woodland as an economic resource and created a material culture of wood which was at least as meaningfully imbued and vastly more prevalent than the sculpture and metalwork with which we associate them today Trees held a central place in Anglo Saxon belief systems which carried into the Christian period not least in the figure of the cross itself Despite this the transience of trees and timber in comparison to metal and stone has meant that the subject has received comparatively little attention from scholars Trees and Timber in the Anglo Saxon World constitutes the very first collection of essays written about the role of trees in early medieval England bringing together established specialists and new voices to present an interdisciplinary insight into the complex relationship between the early English and their woodlands The woodlands of England were not only deeply
