A House Of Women:

The Haunted House in Women's Ghost Stories Emma Liggins, 2020-06-30 This book explores Victorian and modernist haunted houses in female authored ghost stories as representations of the architectural uncanny It reconsiders the gendering of the supernatural in terms of unease denial disorientation confinement and claustrophobia within domestic space Drawing on spatial theory by Gaston Bachelard Henri Lefebvre and Elizabeth Grosz it analyses the reoccupation and appropriation of space by ghosts women and servants as a means of addressing the opposition between the past and modernity The chapters consider a range of haunted spaces including ancestral mansions ghostly gardens suburban villas Italian churches and houses subject to demolition and ruin The ghost stories are read in the light of women's non-fictional writing on architecture travel interior design sacred space technology the ideal home and the servant problem Women writers discussed include Elizabeth Gaskell Margaret Oliphant Vernon Lee Edith Wharton May Sinclair and Elizabeth Bowen This book will appeal to students and researchers in the ghost story Female Gothic and Victorian and modernist women's writing as well as general readers with an interest in the supernatural

Caputo, 2014-07-01 Although halfway houses have been touted for years as affirmative rehabilitation locations that ready women for life in the outside world in this remarkable case study Gail Caputo shows how these places reinforce patterns of control and abuse that reaffirm the dependency and victimization of the inmates Based on observations made while living and working alongside women at a halfway house within the prison system in a city in the Northeast Caputo's analysis is anchored in the words and experiences of over a dozen women Organized according to the progression of levels residents traverse during their time in the house and the rules and behaviors associated with each level Caputo offers a riveting look at what passes for rehabilitation and reintegration in such places and delineates the many ways these women retain agency by resisting regulations designed to keep them in their place

The Women's House of Detention Hugh Ryan, 2022-05-10 This singular history of a prison and the queer women and trans people held there is a window into the policing of queerness and radical politics in the twentieth century The Women's House of Detention a landmark that ushered in the modern era of women's imprisonment is now largely forgotten But when it stood in New York City's Greenwich Village from 1929 to 1974 it was a nexus for the tens of thousands of women transgender men and gender nonconforming people who inhabited its crowded cells Some of these inmates Angela Davis Andrea Dworkin Afeni Shakur were famous but the vast majority were incarcerated for the crimes of being poor and improperly feminine Today approximately 40 percent of the people in women's prisons identify as queer in earlier decades that percentage was almost certainly higher Historian Hugh Ryan explores the roots of this crisis and reconstructs the little known lives of incarcerated
