Publicly funded and mandated archaeology in the United States has been attacked multiple times during the past several years. Many of these attacks occurred at the state level, where governors and state legislatures tried to defund or outright eliminate. state archaeological programs and institutions. At the federal level, we have seen archaeology showcased as a waste of public tax dollars, attempts to defund archaeological research, legislation to move federal projects forward without consideration of impacts.

ABSTRACT

Over the past several years, we have seen many articles on publicly funded and mandated anchoeology in the United States. These attacks occur at the state level, where governors and state legislatures by to defund or outsight eliminate state archaeological programs and institutions. We have also seen several attacks active federally funded or permitted projects forward without consideration of public tax dollars, and others propose legislation to move federally funded or permitted projects forward without consideration of impacts on anchoeological resources. These attacks continue to occur, and we expect them to increase in the future. In the past, a vigilant network of historic preservation and archaeological organizations was able to thewer such attacks. The public, however, largely remains an untapped ally. As a disopline, we have not built a strong public support network. We have not demonstrated the value of anchoeology to the public, beyond a scattering of educational and informational programs.
