The Symphonic Repertoire, Volume IV A. Peter Brown, 2024-03-29 Central to the repertoire of Western art music since the 18th century the symphony has come to be regarded as one of the ultimate compositional challenges Surprisingly heretofore there has been no truly extensive broad based treatment of the genre and the best of the existing studies are now several decades old In this five volume series A Peter Brown explores the symphony from its 18th century beginnings to the

end of the 20th century Synthesizing the enormous scholarly literature Brown presents up to date overviews of the status of research discusses any important former or remaining problems of attribution illuminates the style of specific works and their contexts and samples early writings on their reception The Symphonic Repertoire provides an unmatched compendium of knowledge for the student teacher performer and sophisticated amateur The series is being launched with two volumes on the Viennese symphony Volume IV The Second Golden Age of the Viennese Symphony Brahms Bruckner Dvor k Mahler and Selected Contemporaries Although during the mid 19th century the geographic center of the symphony in the Germanic territories moved west and north from Vienna to Leipzig during the last third of the century it returned to the old Austrian lands with the works of Brahms Bruckner Dvor k and Mahler After nearly a half century in hibernation the sleeping Viennese giant awoke to what some viewed as a reincarnation of Beethoven with the first hearing of Brahms s Symphony No 1 which was premiered at Vienna in December 1876 Even though Bruckner had composed some gigantic symphonies prior to Brahms s first contribution their full impact was not felt until the composer s complete texts became available after World War II Although Dvor k was often viewed as a nationalist composer in his symphonic writing his primary influences were Beethoven Schubert and Brahms For both Bruckner and Mahler the symphony constituted the heart of their output for Brahms and Dvor k it occupied a less central place Yet for all of them the key figure of the past remained Beethoven The symphonies of these four composers together with the works of Goldmark Zemlinsky Schoenberg Berg Smetana Fibich Jan cek and others are treated in Volume IV The Second Golden Age of the Viennese Symphony covering the period from roughly 1860 to 1930

Beethoven's Chamber Music in Context Angus Watson, 2012 A noted violinist and conductor Watson is particularly well suited for his chosen task outlining the historical context and character of more than 50 of the chamber works that Beethoven composed during his years in Vienna Avoiding the pitfalls of becoming too critical or academic the author characterizes each composition in general terms only and does not discuss changing styles of performance Instead Watson provides information on a work s historical background and character and on the musical points of interest in each movement He pays special attention to the influence of Beethoven s large scale compositions on his chamber music and on the composer s increasing mastery of improvisation Filling a hole in scholarship on Beethoven s compositions this book will be greatly appreciated by professional and amateur musicians

Mazurkas Frédéric Chopin, Carl Mikuli, 1987-01-01 Among the best loved and most performed of Chopin s piano compositions are his mazurkas This volume includes 51 works remarkable for their wide emotional appeal advanced chromatic techniques and pianistic devices and ranging in difficulty from relatively easy for advanced beginnings to quite challenging for the accomplished pianist Edited by Carl Mikuli a pupil of Chopin the works in this inexpensive and attractive volume extend from the radiant joyfulness of the Mazurka in B flat major Op 7 No 1 to the aching sadness of the Mazurka in A minor Op 17 No 4 and from the brevity of the Mazurka in E flat minor Op 6 No 4 to the breadth of the C sharp minor Mazurka Op 50 No 3 Pianists and music lovers will welcome this
