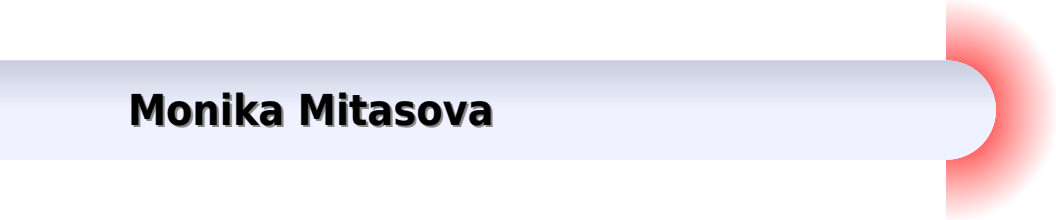

Autonomy and Ideology Robert Somol, 1997 This is the documentation transcripts essays and images of the proceedings of an influential conference held in honor of Philip Johnson Hosted in New York City in February 1996 by the Canadian Centre for Architecture together with the Columbia University School of Architecture Planning and Preservation and the Museum of Modern Art the conference was organized by Phyllis Lambert and Peter Eisenman and convened by Robert Somol The international roster of diverse participants included historians theorists critics and architects who debated such themes as the critical dynamics between museums as institutions and the material they represent the issue of high and low in art and architecture and the potential to expand the concept of the avant garde within the borders of the discipline With the intention of developing a specifically architectural discourse of the modernist avant garde from within and from without the discipline the participants debated the extent to which the practitioners of the avant garde in America were interested in the formal rather than the philosophical political and economic underpinnings of the European movement which to date had remained unexamined They discussed new ways of working and thinking through the problems of modernity as it began to be experienced at the start of the 1920s IAUS, the Institute for Architecture and Urban Studies Suzanne Frank, Suzanne

Shulof Frank, 2010 The book is a combined memoir and impressionistic history of the Institute for Architecture and Urban Studies At first affiliated with New York's Museum of Modern Art and Cornell University the Institute housed architects artists and historians who worked on creative design and intellectual projects and would become world renown Its creation and direction was in the hands of its able leader Peter Eisenman Besides a documentary study of the work that went on there among an international clearing house the book is laced with impressions of the author's experience there It has been in the works for over 12 years and was originally financed by the Graham Foundation for the Study of the Fine Arts and has subsequently been aided by Dr Jenny Kaufmann The photographs of the Institute at the height of its activity are included and so does an original ground plan of its West 40th Street office done by Scott Brandi who also designed the book It ends with 27 interviews of prominent members of the Institute who comment on it and their experiences The book should appeal to architecture students and those interested in architecture and urbanism of the seventies when the government in the United States was more reasonable in economic and political equity **The Routledge Companion to Contemporary**

Goldhagen and Alice Friedman on modernism's forbidden elements of the honorific and the visually pleasurable. It highlights the significance of pavilionizing mid-century designers such as Victor Lundy, John Johansen, Eero Saarinen, and Edward Durrell Stone, and shows how frequently essentialist and traditionalist types appeared in the roadside vernacular of drive-in restaurants, gas stations, furniture and car showrooms, branch banks, and motels. The book ties together the threads in mid-century architectural theory that addressed aspects of type, essential structure, and primal humanistic aspects of environment making, and discusses how these concerns outlived the mid-century moment and in the designs and writings of Aldo Rossi and others they paved the way for Post Modernism.
